Dues are based on total credits taught during the 2011-2012 academic year.

We cannot begin this process until we receive notification from your employer confirming your appointment and the number of credits you are teaching.

Minnesota law allows MSCF to collect “non-member” (fair share) dues from faculty members who elect not to become members of the organization. The non-member fee is used to cover the costs of contract negotiation and enforcement, among other things. This generally means that MSCF will collect from these faculty members about 85% of the full dues of membership, as reflected in the charts in this brochure.

Non-member faculty will be notified 30 days in advance of any non-member assessment.
