This is to memorialize our conversation around the issue of the right of a faculty member to have a student who is disruptive removed from a class.

The Labor Relations Department of MnSCU agrees that faculty should have the right to remove a disruptive student from a class session and that the return of the student is subject to the relevant policy of the college.

Further, it is my opinion that each college should address these situations in a manner which affirms the faculty member's rights and addresses fully the procedure for establishing the conditions, if any, for the return of the student to the class as soon as practicable and safe.
